Gwilym was born about 1412 of Pentre Evan, Pembroke, Wales. He married Agnes daughter of James who was son of Howell, and they had one son, Owen.

Owen ap Gwilym, of Pentre Evan, married Janett, the daughter and heiress of John ap Henry ap Llewelyn, Gumfreston, and they had 4 children. There 1st child was, James.

Sir James was born about 1480, of Pentre Evan, Pembroke, Wales. He was 1st married to Jane, daughter of Jenkyn Perott, about 1503 and by her had 10 children, all born or lived in Pentre Evan, Pembroke, Wales.

After Jane's death, Sir James Bowen married second, about 1518, Mary, daughter of John Herle and Margaret daughter of Thomas.

Sir James and Mary had twelve children born in Llwyngwair, Pembroke, Wales. Their 4th Son was Mathias Bowen.

Mathias Bowen was born about 1524, of LLwyngwair, Pembroke, Wales. He married about 1548, Mary, daughter of John Phylips, son

of John Phylips, Knight, of Picton Castle and Elizabeth. They were blessed with twelve children all of LLwyngwair, Pembroke, Wales. Their first son was James.
