

### History of Anthony Perry

Anthony, son of Edmund Perry and Sarah, was born in England about 1624. He came to America with his parents.

Anthony acquired a large landed property in Rehoboth, Massachusetts. He was one of the first settlers there in 1643. He represented the town in the general assembly of the colony.

He married Elizabeth about 1647. They were blessed with six children which were born in Rehoboth, Bristol, Massachusetts.

He contributed liberally to the support of the King Philip's War in 1675. He was buried March 1683. His wife Elizabeth died 14 May 1703.

### History of Edmund Perry

Edmund Perry was born about 1588, in England. He married Sarah about 1613; they were residents of Devon, England, which is probably the place their nine children were born.

Edmund and Sarah brought their family to America. They settled in Massachusetts or Plymouth Colonies; probably in Rehoboth.

Edmund died in 1614 in Sandwich, Barnstable, Massachusetts.
