

### History of Benjamin Adams

Benjamin was born 22 April 1710, at Ipswich, Essex, Massachusetts, son of Thomas Adams and Bethia Blanchard.

Benjamin married Persis in 1731.

They were blessed with 15 children. The first three were born in Marlborough, Middlesex, Massachusetts. The remaining 12 were born in Brookfield, Worcester, Massachusetts.
