My Grandfather Horsnaile's Grandfather's Name was William, but commonly call'd Serjeant Horsnaile: He was Serjeant of the County Militia: He liv'd on and was possess'd of the Spot which my Uncle George Horsnaile now enjoys. He was encamp'd at Tilbury Fort when Queen Elizabeth went in Person and rode from Rank to Rank with a Truncheon in her Hand, which our Historians give a particular Account of. He married ----- Wattleton of Reading, who had four Sons and four Daughters, viz. Gilbert, Stephen, William, Christopher; Joan, Catharine, Grace and Elizabeth, to all which Children he gave Lands for their Portions.

Gilbert Horsnaile, eldest Son of the Serjeant, married Ann, Daughter of Thomas Edwin of Pangbourn, by whom he had one Son and three Daughters, viz. Gilbert, Ann and two other Daughters, who died unmarried.

Gilbert Horsnaile, Son of Gilbert, and Grandson of the Serjeant, married Susannah, Daughter of William Boyce of Warfield, who had two Sons and three Daughters.
