History of Isaac Mixer 1569

Isaac Mixer was born about 1569 in England. He married to Frances about 1593. She was born about 1573. They were blessed with nine children. Isaac was a weaver by trade. They lived part of their life in Capel, Suffolk, England as they were both buried there. Frances was buried 24 February 1620 and Isaac was buried 25 March 1642.

History of Isaac Mixer 1602

Isaac Mixer was christened on 3 October 1602 in Capel, Suffolk, England. He married Sarah Thurston on 11 May 1629 in Capel, Suffolk, England.

In "Pioneers of Massachusetts" by Pope it gives the following:

"Isaac Mixer, (Mixter) age 31 with wife Sarah, age, 33, and son Isaac, age 4, embarked for New England from Ipswich, England, 10 April 1634. Settled at Watertown, Mass. Proprietor 1636. Free man 2 May 1638, he was a town officer and clerk of a train band."

Another reference gives the name of the ship they came on as the "Elizabeth" and the master of the ship, William Andrews. The name of Isaac Mixer is on the earliest list of proprietors of Watertown, 1636. He was a selectman. On 1 April 1651, he was appointed by the County Clerk, sealer of weights and measures. He owned 1/2 of the vessel Diligent. When his will was proved 19 June 1655 this vessel was at sea, where John Sheperd, under God was Master. Isaac's will dated 8 May 1655 mentions his wife Sarah, son Isaac and daughter Sarah Stearns. He left 1/2 of the vessel Diligent to his daughter Sarah, which was appraised at 25 pounds.

History of Isaac Mixer 1630

Isaac Mixer was born 1630 probably in Capel, Suffolk, England, or Ipswich, Essex, England. When only 4 years old he came to Watertown, Middlesex, Massachusetts, on the "Elizabeth" with his father Isaac and his mother Sarah. Here he endured the hardships along with them, but as he grew older he no doubt helped his father on the farm, then when he was given land, his father helped him put his land under cultivation.

Isaac Mixer took the Oath of Fidelity in 1652.

He was married three times; first in Watertown, 19 September 1655, to Mary Coolidge, daughter of John Coolidge and Mary. They were blessed with two children both born at Watertown.

Isaac's wife Mary died 2 November 1660, in Watertown.

Isaac Mixer married second on 10 January 1661 in Watertown to Rebecca Garfield, daughter of Edward Garfield and Rebecca Johnson.

They were bless with 13 children which were born in Watertown.

Rebecca died in 16 March 1684 at Watertown.

Isaac married third to Mary Lathrop in 1687, a daughter of Thomas Lathrop and the widow of William French of Billerica.

Isaac Mixer died 22 November 1716 an aged man. His widow survived him many years, she was living in 1735, very aged.

History of Joanna Mixer 1666

Joanna Mixerborn 14 December 1666 in Watertown, Middlesex Massachusetts, daughter of Isaac Mixer and Rebecca Garfield.

Joanna was married first to Joseph Harrington. After his death she married Obadiah Ward on 20 December 1693.

They were blessed with nine children which were born in Sudbury, Middlesex, Massachusetts.

She died sometime after 1725.
