Sarah Thurston was born about 1601 in Ipswich of Capel, Suffolk, England. Sarah married Isaac Mixer on 11 May 1629 in Capel, Suffolk, England. They were blessed with two children.

When their son Isaac was 4 years old they left Ipswich, England and came to New England on the ship "Elizabeth." The master of the ship was William Andrews. They left 10 April 1634. They settled at Watertown, Middlesex, Massachusetts. They were some of the first settlers there.

She died on 24 November 1681.
