Quick Family History

The Quirks were found in all parts of the Isle of Mann - the name is a contracted form of an Irish surname beginning with Mac, and in its amended form being purely Manx - thus developing from Mac Cuire, "Corc's son" (a Corc having been King of Munster early in the fifth century). Of this Margaret direct antecedents we have no knowledge; but Margaret, Christian, and Isabell are contemporaries, and lived in the same area. It is possible, that Margaret and Christian are sisters or cousin and that they intern are cousin of Isabell's.

Margaret Quirk was born 1706 of Patrick, Isle of Mann and married Henry Quayle on 22 Jul 1726.

Christian Quirk was born on 10 February 1709 in German, Isle of Mann the daughter of John Quirk and Margaret Waterman. Christian married John Addy on 18 July 1741. She died on 16 August 1753.

Isabell was born 28 February 1709 in German, Isle of Mann, the daughter of William Quirk. Isabell married Phillip Mylchreest on 5 November 1738. She died on 12 April 1762.
